Every Shade is specially manufactured to match your needs and fulfill them. In every order you will find additional to the shade, the necessary installation brackets and screws.



There are two positions that before installing our product you should know:

1. Swivel Open
2. Swivel Close



Ceiling Mount

1. Measure 3" from each end of the window and make a small pencil mark. Space any additional brackets evenly.



2. Place the bracket against the ceiling and using one of the screws provided, attach it to the ceiling. (Walls made in sheetrock are recommended to use anchors). For concrete use tapcons.

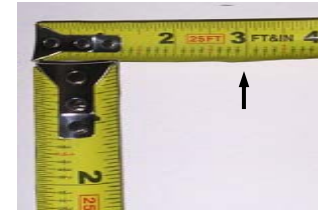


3. Place the headrail against the bracket with the swivel in open position. Then rotate the swivel to a close position. (Check that the headrail is being secured by the bracket).



Wall Mount

1. Mark with a pencil the desired length of the shade. Then measure 3" of the ends of the headrail. Space any additional brackets evenly.



2. Place the bracket against the wall and using two of the screws provided, attach it to the wall.



3. Repeat step number 3 for Ceiling Mount.
